AUTUMN DISPLAY.



1	<i>Vitis vin.</i> 'purpurea' Ornamental Grape.	Vigorous growing, rambling vine with rich autumn colours. Hardy, deciduous. Plant in well drained, moisture retentive soil. Prefers cool, southern regions. Small grape-like fruit. Best in sunny position.
2	<i>Photinia</i> Red Robin.	Evergreen, 2-3m. Quick growing bushy plant with brilliant red new leaves, becoming green as they mature. Excellent screening tree.
3	<i>Pittosporum</i> 'Elfin'	Compact, dwarf plant with tight foliage. Suitable for topiary balls or hedging. Retains foliage deep into plant. Plant in full sun or partial shade in free-draining soil. 0.5 x 0.5m.
4	<i>Prunus</i> 'Shirotae' Mt. Fuji Cherry	Deciduous, 5m. Small spreading tree, semi-double snow white flowers with Hawthorne fragrance. Leaves turn golden-yellow in autumn.
5	<i>Liquidamber styraciflua</i> Liquidamber 'Worplesdon'	Deciduous 8 x 5m. Narrow lobed leaves giving brilliant display of yellow/orange then pink/purple in autumn.
6	<i>Parthenocissus tricuspidata</i> 'Veitchi' Japanese Ivy	Rapid growing creeper Bronze/purple leaves turn a deep green, then rich crimson in autumn.
7	<i>Phormium</i> 'Apricot Queen' Flax	Outstanding dwarf form. Cream leaves flushed apricot when young, maturing to creamy-yellow with green/bronze margins. Grows in any reasonable soil. Full or part sun. 0.75 x 0.75m.
8	<i>Cotoneaster dammeri</i> Cotoneaster	Vigorous semi-evergreen with small leaves and long, trailing habit. Heavy crops of orange/red fruits in autumn. Attractive to bird life.
9	<i>Hebe ochracea</i> Hebe 'James Stirling'	Evergreen, confined to Alpine regions, typically growing in snowy tussock country. Distinctive whipcord form with dense spreading habit. Small white flowers on short spikes during summer.
10	<i>Libertia ixioides</i> NZ Iris	Small native Iris, grows to 50cm. Bright golden spikes make for winter colour. White flowers held above foliage. Hardy, will grow in most soils.
11	<i>Cercis Canadensis</i> Forest Pansy	Deciduous, hardy once established. Stunning broad, purple leaved foliage. Prune lightly for colour. 8m.
12	<i>Coleonema pulchrum</i> 'Sunset Gold' Breath of Heaven	Golden foliated evergreen shrub with pink star flowers in summer. Fragrant, feather-like foliage with a compact, low growing habit. Hardy, prefers full sun. 60cm.
13	<i>Cotinus coggygria</i> European Smoke bush	Deciduous, bushy spreading shrub. Bright green leaves turning to orange/red in autumn. Early summer profusion of smoky grey/purple flowers. 2-3m.
14	<i>Acer P. dissectum</i> 'Crimson Queen' Weeping Maple	Fine selected weeping Maple with scarlet stems. Long, finely dissected deep red/purple leaves. Retains leaf colour throughout summer, turning fiery red in autumn. 1 x 1.5m.
15	<i>Anemanthele lessoniana</i> Wind Grass	A graceful tussock with narrow drooping leaves and feathery flower heads. 1m.
16	<i>Carex testacea</i> Tussock	Densely tufted grass. Colour varies from lime green to bronze/brown. Hardy, drought tolerant, useful for coastal gardens. 50-60cm.
